

Anybody manipulating controls of an R-22/R-44

Must have Awareness Training endorsement 2(a)(3) or endorsement from FAA safety inspector

Pilot RC/H

Student

Instructor

To act as PIC

To Solo

To provide instruction or flight review

- 200 hrs in RC/H
- 50 hrs in R-22*

- 20 hrs dual in R-22/R-44
- Solo Endorsement 2(b)(3)

- 200 hrs RC/H
- 50 hrs R-22*

- 10 hrs dual*
- PIC Endorsement 2(b)(1)(ii)

Valid 90 days

- Has 2(b)(5)(iii) training

Within 12 mos, must have flight review in R-22 and have endorsement per 2(c)

- Has endorsement 2(b)(5)(iv)

Awareness Training 2(a)(3) from certified instructor

- Energy management
- Mast bumping
- Low rotor RPM/blade stall
- Low G hazards
- Rotor RPM decay

For R44:

*indicates ½ of required hours must be in an R44

Endorsements 5(iv) from FAA safety inspector or DPE

- Completed appropriate training
- Meets experience requirements
- Demonstrated instruction for 2(a)(3) Awareness Training and areas in 2(b)(5)(iii)
